

Book of Mormon Lands

Some place names are relative, and any attempt to indicate a specific location is not intended.

Bountiful, even from the **east** unto the **west sea**, and thus the Nephites ...had hemmed in the Lamanites on the south that thereby they should have no more possession on the north, that they might not overrun the **land northward**. Therefore the Lamanites could have no more possessions only in the **land of Nephi**, and the **wilderness round about**. ...that they might have a country whither they might flee...” (Alma 22:33-34)

“the **waters of Ripliancum** [Sea West], which, by interpretation, is **large**, or to **exceed all**” (Ether 15:8)

“...Coriantumr came up unto the **land of Moron**, and ...did press forward upon Lib, that he fled to the **borders upon the seashore** [West Sea]. And ... Shiz [brother of Lib] did pursue Coriantumr **eastward**, even to the **borders by the seashore** [East Sea], and there he gave battle unto Shiz...” (Ether 14:11, 26)

“...it was only the distance of a **day** and a **half’s journey**... on the line **Bountiful** and the **land Desolation**, from the **east to the west sea**; and thus the land of **Nephi** and the **land of Zarahemla** were nearly surrounded by **water**, there being a **small neck of land** between the **land northward** and the **land southward**.” (Alma 22:32)

“Hagoth ... built him an exceedingly large ship, on the borders of the **land Bountiful**, by the **land Desolation**, and launched it forth into the **west sea**, by the **narrow neck** which led into the **land northward**.” (Alma 63:5)

“...the head of the **river Sidon**,
running from the **east towards**
the west...” (Alma 22:27)

“... Zoram and his sons crossed over the **river Sidon**, with their armies, and marched away beyond the **borders of Manti** into the **south wilderness**, which was on the **east side of the river Sidon**” (Alma 16:7)

“Now the **land south** was called Lehi, and the **land north** was called Mulek ... for the Lord did bring Mulek into the **land north**, and Lehi into the **land south**” (Hel. 6:10)

“...they did multiply and spread, and did go forth from the **land southward** to the **land northward**, and ... to cover the face of the whole earth, from the **sea south** to the **sea north**, from the **sea west** to the **sea east**.” (Hel. 3:8)

“...we have been driven out of the land of our inheritance [Jerusalem]; but we have been led to a better land, for the Lord has made **the sea** our path, and we are upon an **isle of the sea.**” (2 Ne. 10:20)

“...and we began to **plant seeds**;
yea, we did put all our seeds into the
earth, which we had brought from the
land of Jerusalem. And it came to
pass that they did **grow**
exceedingly.” (1 Ne. 18:24)

Sea North

“... they should flee to the land which was **northward**, which was covered with **large bodies of water**, and take possession of the land which was **northward**.” (Alma 50:29)

“...Omer departed out of the land [Moron] with his family, and traveled many days, and came over and passed by the **hill of Shim**, and came over by the place where the Nephites were destroyed, and from thence **eastward**, and came to a place which was called **Ablom, by the seashore...**” (Ether 9:3)

“... the borders of the **land Desolation**; ... by the **narrow pass** which led **by the sea** into the **land northward**, yea, by the **sea, on the west and on the east.**” (Alma 50:34)

“And they built a great city by the **narrow neck of land**, by the place where **the sea divides the land.**”
(Ether 10:20)

Sea Divides the Land

“...the city of **Nephihah**, and the city of **Lehi**, and the city of **Morianton**, and the city of **Omner**, and the city of **Gid**, and the city of **Mulek**, all of which were on the **east borders by the seashore**.” (Alma 51:26)

Sea East

“...they had come into the **center of the land**, and had taken the capital city which was the **city of Zarahemla**...”
(Hel. 1:23)

“**[Land of Nephi]** ... was divided from the **land of Zarahemla** by a **narrow strip of wilderness**, which ran from the **sea east** even to the **sea west**.” (Alma 22:27)

“[From the waters of **Mormon** ...they fled **eight days**’ journey into the wilderness. And they came to [H]elam],...and when they had traveled **all day** ... they called the **valley Alma**,... And after they had been in the wilderness **twelve days** they arrived in the **land of Zarahemla**] (Mosiah 23:3-4; 24:20, 25. A 21-day journey)

“[Land of Nephi] ... was bordering even to the **sea, on the east and on the west** ...” (Alma 22:27)

“... we did find upon the **land of promise**, as we journeyed in the wilderness, that there were **beasts in the forests** of every kind, both the cow and the ox, and the ass and the horse, and the goat and the wild goat, and all manner of wild animals, which were for the use of men. And we did find all manner of ore, both of **gold**, and of **silver**, and of
